# न तत्र चक्षुर्गच्छति न वाग्गच्छति नो मनः । न विद्मो न विजानीमोयथैतदनुशिष्यात् ॥ ३॥

The literal meaning of this Shlok 3 of Chapter 1 of the Kena Upanishad is "There where the eyes does not reach, speech doesnot reach (because it cannot be described in words), even the mind cannot reach there! We do not understand how anyone can teach that."

Beyond the literal meaning of the above shloka, there is a deeper connection to be felt. The point made in this shloka is: the spiritual master says that even he cannot make his student understand the ultimate consciousness because it is not something which eyes can see, nor words can express and neither can mind fathom it. BUT, our Guruji did this very easily, every single time he spoke. He way described non-linear the understanding the supreme consciousness - Swami, When I first read and heard about this shloka - न तत्र चक्षुर्गच्छति न वाग्गच्छति नोमनः , it did not

resonate with me because if Swami is the ultimate consciousness and the supreme truth, then Guruji has already shown us how to see, express and feel Swami's presence around us - the nonlinear way.

Upanishads are teachings where the teacher sits close to the student and imparts him knowledge about the life, about the ultimate truth. # "Guruji" - with us everytime everywhere!



A Sadhak is a seeker, one who is aspirant of moksha, one who is thirsty for the truth, but if one cannot know





# Chapter 19th

जनक उवाच ॥ तत्त्वविज्ञानसन्दंशमादाय हृदयोदरात् । नाविधपरामर्शशल्योद्धारः कृतो मया ॥ १९ -१॥

19.1 Meaning: King Janaka is satisfied with his self realization and tells Astavakra that with the tongs of Truth, I have plucked the thorns of wrong thinking from the innermost cave of my heart.

Janaka realized he was considering the worldly illusions as truth but now with Guru's grace he has realized that the world is illusion and now he has known the reality about the Self.

> क्व धर्मः क्व च वा कामः क्व चार्थः क्व विवेकिता । क्व द्वैतं क्व च वाऽद्वैतं स्वमहिम्नि स्थितस्य मे ॥ १९ -२॥

19.2 Meaning: For an enlightened being there is no meditation, no pleasure, no prosperity or discrimination. He is free from duality. He feels either united nor separated. In that blissful everything is one. Nothing is more important and nothing is less important. He is merged into his self.

क्व भूतं क्व भविष्यद् वा वर्तमानमपि क्व वा । क्व देशः क्व च वा नित्यं स्वमहिम्नि स्थितस्य मे ॥ १९ -३॥

19.3 Meaning: For a realized soul, there is no past no future nor present

He is neither bothered about past and nor concerned about future. For him there is no space and no eternity, everything is one. He is in the state of being where everything happens. He is free from the state of doingness. For him the doer and task has become one.

क्व चात्मा क्व च वानात्मा क्व शुभं क्वाशुभं यथा । क्व चिन्ता क्व च वाचिन्ता स्वमहिम्नि स्थितस्य मे ॥ १९ -४॥

19.4 Meaning:

An enlightened being is so much happy with his state where he is not aware about self also. Neither good pleases him not evil bothers him. He is neither confused not clear. He is still in his atmabhava. (soul consciousness)

क्व स्वप्नः क्व सुषुप्तिर्वा क्व च जागरणं तथा । क्व तुरीयं भयंवापि स्वमहिम्नि स्थितस्य मे॥ १९ -५॥

19.5 Meaning:

A realized being is not aware about dreaming state nor waking state. He is not aware about deep sleep and also not aware about Turiya (meditative). In dreaming state a common man gets either excited or fearful based on the experience one gets but a realized soul is even free from that. He is established fully in his soul consciousness.



# **Ashram Wisdom**

To be in Atmabhava does not mean not to expect anything and not to make efforts to achieve it.



In one of the seminar, one participant asked that you said that Reiki has divine intelligence and gives you whatever is necessary for life. Does that mean we should not make efforts to achieve anything in life?

While discussing the features of Reiki, we always say during seminar that Reiki has its own divine intelligence. It gives whatever is good for you or necessary for you. In this connection, one of the participants asked that does that mean we should not make efforts or have an ambition. We can always strive to achieve whatever we want in life but we should not have desire and make efforts to achieve those desire. But after having worked to achieve that desire, even if things are not happening as per your wishes, then we should accept that fulfilling that desire may not be good for Because Reiki gives you what is appropriate in life. When we believe that by hook or crook we have to achieve it then there is a problem. There is nothing

wrong in having expectation of good result but when this expectation turns in ego game our expectation becomes desire (Aasakti) which not is acceptable. That desire comes out of ego and we manipulate things to achieve it.

To flow with the flow of life is what we say to be in Atmabhava. We should strive to achieve whatever we want in life but should not crave for it. If we are practicing and experiencing Reiki in life, then Reiki will give you what is appropriate in life. If it will be harmful for you in the long run, it may not give you. At that time we have to be in acceptance. Reiki is like a mother who would not give a knife in the hands of a small child. So just make your efforts in be in surrender with right kind of understanding.
